About the London Clinical Senate.

The London Clinical Senate is an independent body within London's Health and Social Care system. Hosted by NHS England, it supports the transformation of healthcare in the city by providing Commissioners, Providers and Clinicians with independent, clinical, and strategic advice.

The Senate Council is the Senate's governing body. Its members are senior health and care professionals from across the city. As the period of office of a number of our members is expiring the Senate is currently recruiting new members for the Council.

Becoming a Senate Council member is an excellent way to further develop clinical leadership skills, gain experience of working across London's healthcare systems, and play a part in the transformation of healthcare in the city and the implementation of the Long Term Plan.

Who can be a Senate Council member

Council membership is open to senior health and social care professionals working in London. A senior health and social care professional is a:

- a Doctor, Nurse, or Midwife,
- an Allied Health Professional,
- a Healthcare Scientist,
- a Healthcare Academic,
- a Dentist, Optometrist or a Pharmacist.
- a Social Care professional

Council members actively participate in the work of the Clinical Senate.

This includes attending council meetings, taking part in clinical reviews and overseeing the work of the Senate. The Council meets 5 times a year.

The Selection Process. Council members will be selected on the basis of their application, an interview and their fit with the Council member person specification. We want to recruit 10 new members to the Council. As the Council lacks representation from some professions and from some STPs then our selection if new council members will seek to address that imbalance.

Interviews will take place in mid February. Successful applicants will join the Council in March.
