## **WORKPLACE CONTACT**

A CSP workplace contact is an informal role for members, acting as a voice of the CSP in the workplace.

We are seeking workplace contacts to:

- Help organise member meetings and other workplace events
- Sharing info about CSP workplace activity and campaigns
- Help your steward map and recruit members in your workplace.

We want to build a local CSP team in every workplace. Although the role is voluntary and does not come with paid time off, any member can put themselves forward.

This is not a standalone role and forms part of the CSP team, alongside the CSP steward and safety rep.\*

\*In organisations where there are currently no stewards, the workplace contact may be a standalone role until such time as a steward is elected. In this case, you will receive strong support led by the CSP organising team.

### **STEWARD**

Becoming a CSP steward means that you become part of a national team that forms the trade union function of the CSP. We are seeking stewards to:

- Represent members with workplace problems
- Negotiate with management representing your members' views
- Recruit new members including support workers.

### **SAFETY REP**

Become a CSP safety rep and be a part of a national team of safety reps, who ensure a healthy and safe working environment for CSP members. We are seeking safety reps to:

- Carry out health & safety inspections
- Be an advocate for members at health and safety meetings
- Ensure managers consult with you, on behalf of members, regarding risk assessment findings, new technology and new equipment.
