Placement overview

The Marillac Neurological Care Centre is an independent charity that provide high quality of care and specialist treatment for 52 people who have a complex Neurological and physical disabilities. We have a specialised MDT's including a Physiotherapist, Nurse, Occupational Therapist, Speech and Language Therapist, Music Therapist, Psychologist, Dietician, GP and Neuro Consultant. We provide face to face treatment daily and the number of sessions depend on patient funding from Continuing Health Care, Slow stream rehabilitation, Rehabilitation or D2A (Discharge to assess).

Supervision: 2:1 face to face supervision.

Top tips for others:

- Give allocated secured time for reflection, feedback and supervision. Constructive criticism is the best way to give to the students for them to enable to reach their goals whilst during placements
- Have a regular meeting with the students to check on how they are getting on with their caseloads, e.g. assessment, outcome measures, treatment plans, guidelines, meetings, reports.
- Be a good listener and give your support from day one of their induction. Inform them that they are part of the team. Seek a once a week feedback from the students for you to know where can you improve as a Practice Educator
